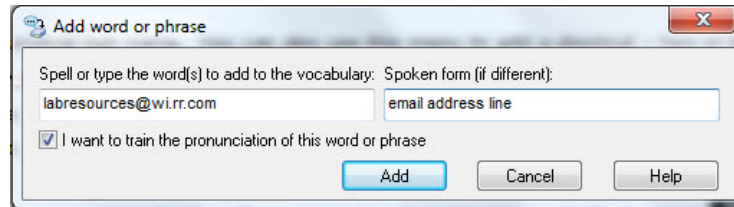
Dragon Corner

This regular column answers a commonly asked question about Dragon NaturallySpeaking

Question: What is a shortcut and how do I create one in Dragon ?

Answer: A shortcut is the use of two or three words to bring up a phrase or sentence that you frequently use. For example, a shortcut could insert the name of your school when you say "school name" or bring up your email address when you say "email address line". Here are the steps to create a shortcut to insert your email address into a document.

1. Click **Vocabulary**, then **Add new word or phrase**.
2. Type in the word or words you would like Dragon to type. Try typing in your e-mail address.
3. Under **Spoken form**, type 2 or 3 words you would like to say to bring up this phrase. Type or say **email address line** for the spoken form.



4. Click **Add**.
5. Train this short cut. Click **Go** and say **email address line**. Repeat 2 times. Dragon is more accurate if a word or phrase is trained several times.. Click **Done**..
6. Try dictating **email address line** into your document. Did Dragon type your actual e-mail address?

Dragon comes with a number of pre-made shortcuts. Some of these shortcuts allow you to search the web by voice or search your desktop by voice, We will look at these in the next newsletter.

PEARL Camera + WYNN 6

Do you find scanning documents into your reading software to be a time-consuming and laborious task?

The PEARL camera works with the new WYNN 6 to provide instant OCR. Press the keystroke to snap a picture and hear your book read back to you with one of WYNN's Real-Speak Solo Direct voices.

Use the PEARL to read textbooks, magazines, research documents, and paperbacks. WYNN identifies

columns and places them in a logical reading order.

In automatic mode, the PEARL senses motion, so it knows to snap an image whenever you turn a page.
