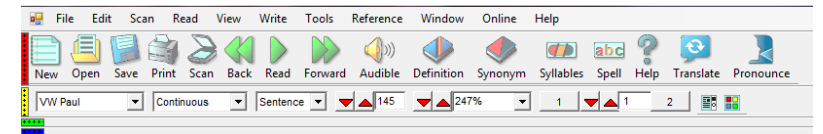

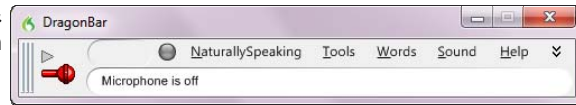
# Dragon Corner

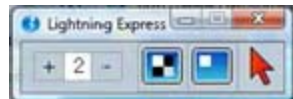
The first tool in the Speak & See Suite is Dragon NaturallySpeaking Preferred.



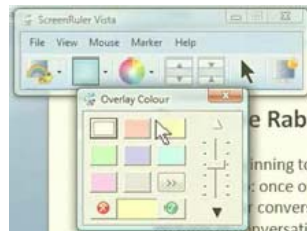
The second tool is the Speak & See toolbar. Nearly any on-screen text can be spoken aloud by the computer using 1 of the 8 Real Speak voices. Bilingual dictionaries, homophone dictionary, thesaurus, reference dictionary and spell checker are included in this toolbar.



The third tool is the Screen Magnifier, which allows the user to magnify a portion or all of the computer screen up to 6 times.



The fourth tool is the Screen Ruler, designed to assist the user when viewing text on the screen. It provides a strip or ruler across the screen—you can vary the contrast and have the background colored or grayed out.
